From the Pastors

Words to Live By

"Man does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God' (Matthew 4:4).

Dear Brothers and Sisters of our Lord Jesus Christ,

The Word of God matters. With His Word, God created and sustains all things. With His Word Incarnate, God redeemed the world from sin and death. With His Word, He sanctifies His Church, making her holy to Him. We live by the word of the Lord but die without it. "The words I have spoken to you," Jesus says, "are spirit and life" (John 6:63). It's why God the Father said of Him, "This is my Son, my Chosen One; listen to him!" (Luke 9:35). The psalmist highlights what listening and studying the word of God does for us. "The unfolding of Your words gives light; it imparts understanding to the simple. I open my mouth and pant because I long for Your commandments. Turn to me and be gracious to me, as is Your way with those who love Your name" (Psalm 119:130-132). In commenting on this passage Dr. Carol Geisler writes, "We know what it is to thirst for a cool drink of water on a hot day, to long for daylight after a sleepless night, or to wait with joyful longing for a friend or family member after a long absence. The psalmist is longing, panting with open mouth, not for water or daylight or his family, but for the Word of God. For him, the Lord's teachings were as refreshing as cool, still waters in a green pasture." It's the same with us.

On Sunday, September 12th, we resume Sunday School and Bible classes at Trinity. We invite you to join us and your children in-between Divine Services for the study of God's Word. After catching up with others in the lounge while enjoying some coffee or other refreshments, head on into the Gym for a study entitled, "God's Word to Us – A Path to Discovery." This study will lead you through the entire Scriptures in a way that is approachable, engaging, and transformative. If you are seeking membership at Trinity, or, if you would like a refresher course in the main teachings of Scripture, stop in the Fellowship Hall for a class entitled, "Catechesis for Life."

Coming together for the study of God's word is enlightening, comforting, and a wonderful way to get to know one anther better. In addition, we will grow in our faith toward God and in our care for one another. "The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God will stand forever." (Isaiah 40:8).

The 2021-22 school year is off and running! We are so excited to teacher our students that God is with us in ALL thing! We are grateful for your support. Please pray for us this school year!
















Why go to Sunday Morning Sunday School or Bible Class?
